For a better understanding of what you can expect as a volunteer and what is expected of you by our organization, we ask you to read and sign the following Volunteer Contract.

What you can expect when volunteering for us:

The North Olympic Discover Marathon (NODM) values its volunteers and we will endeavor to provide you with:

- a written position description so you understand your role and the tasks you are authorized to perform (attached)
- any necessary training which may help you complete your volunteer duties
- a safe environment in which to perform your role
 a supervisor or contact person, so that you have the opportunity to
 ask questions and get feedback

What does NODM asks of its volunteers?

We ask that you:

- support NODM's aims and objectives. While volunteering for us, you are a representative of this organization.
- attend the volunteer training
- notify your supervisor or the volunteer coordinator if you have any questions or concerns about safety or potentially hazardous situations that may pose a risk to you or others
- use your best judgment and act appropriately and courteously
- use any property or equipment given to you in your role safely and only for purpose of the role and return it to the organization when you finish your volunteer role
- have fun and agree to ask questions if needed or provide feedback if we can improve our volunteer program and the support that you receive. We are here for you!
