Position Summary:

An area **Trail Maintenance Leader** furthers Peninsula Trails Coalition's goals by performing, leading and coordinating trail section maintenance on the Olympic Discovery Trail (ODT or "the trail.")

Required Qualifications:

- 1. 18 years of age or older.
- 2. First Aid/CPR/AED and/or Wilderness First Aid certifications. If not already certified, the course must be passed during the first 2 months of employment. Certification must be maintained during employment.
- 3. Experience with workplace safety practices.
- 4. Able to lead volunteers by example.
- 5. 1+ years field experience including trail maintenance or conservation work.
- 6. Knowledge of trail design, construction, and maintenance.
- 7. Proficient with hand tools and small power equipment.
- 8. Valid driver's license and clean driving record. Experience towing equipment, trailers.
- 9. Self-motivated with a desire to take initiative, be a leader, work efficiently and communicate appropriately with diverse community groups.

Essential Duties:

- 1. Clearly and thoroughly communicates with all stakeholders in efforts to maintain the ODT. Written reports are required at least monthly.
- 2. Monitors trail conditions in the assigned area, responds quickly, and personally to problems.
- 3. Plans and leads PTC maintenance and construction efforts to resolve problems not resolved in 2.
- 4. Assumes responsibility for safety, organization and leadership of PTC volunteers in maintaining or improving the trail.
- 5. Operates hand tools, power tools, machinery and light equipment.
- 6. Trains and qualifies volunteers for safe operation of PTC provided tools.
- 7. Coordinates with multiple jurisdictional maintenance efforts in the section assigned.
- 8. Works with other section Trail maintenance leaders to accomplish larger tasks.
- 9. Assumes responsibility for maintaining, storing, repairing, and keeping adequate records for all PTC trail maintenance equipment available for the area.

- 10. Expected to become quickly familiar with the PTC Trail Maintenance Handbook and Guideline for Signs & Structures documents. Contributes to improvements in these and other trail documentation.
- 11. Coordinates trail maintenance and upgrade efforts with Trail Adopters and Adopt-a-Trail Managers
- 12. Leads or coordinates with the volunteer "Tiger Team" trail maintenance efforts.
- 13. Work will involve work parties on weekends and weekday evenings.
- 14. Performs other related duties as directed by the respective area Vice President.
- 15. Conducts and maintains volunteer hours reporting.

Desired Additional Qualifications:

- 1. 2+ years of project management experience including coordinating programs and/or managing staff and/or volunteers.
- 2. Chainsaw operation experience and certification. (Certification will be sponsored during employment.)
- 3. Heavy equipment and/or construction operation and maintenance experience.
- 4. Experience constructing trail foundations, bridge supports and drainage structures to provide engineering drawings.
